

### ATHLETIC PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Boys cross country qualified as a team for the MHSAA state finals for the first time in school history.
- Boys soccer won their 8th CHSL division title in school history.
- Girls swimming and diving won the Royal Oak Relays and Romeo Relays for the second consecutive year.
- Volleyball won their 11th district title and 5th regional title in school history.
- Boys and girls basketball both won district titles. It was the 5th district title for the boys and 4th for the girls in school history.
- Competitive cheer took home championships from three tournaments during the regular season—CCCAM @ Wyandotte Roosevelt, the Lapeer East Classic and the Marine City Invitational.
- Boys ice hockey advanced to the Frozen Four for the first time in school history and won their 2nd regional title in school history.
- Girls ski won their 4th regional title in school history and qualified for the state finals as a team for the 5th time in school history.
- Boys golf won their first state championship and the first state championship in a boys sport in school history.
- Girls and boys lacrosse both won the CHSL championship and CHSL division titles for the second consecutive year. It was the first ever CHSL championship for the girls and 4th in school history for the boys.
- Girls soccer won their 4th district title and their 3rd CHSL division title in school history.
- Girls tennis won the CHSL co-championship. It was the 4th time in school history they have won a CHSL championship.
- Boys track and field had their first ever all state athlete in junior Chris Burns who placed third in the 2 mile with a time of 9:31.28.


