



#### **Girls Cross Country**

For the second straight year, the girls cross country team earned the title of Operation Friendship champions. Junior Risa Juliano qualified for the state finals with a ninth place finish at the regional meet and ended up finishing 119<sup>th</sup> at the Division 2 Finals.

#### **Football**

The varsity football team enjoyed a successful campaign once again in 2008. They went 8-1 in the regular season and repeated as CHSL Prep Bowl champions at Ford Field (second title in school history). They qualified for the MHSAA playoffs where they fell to Detroit Crockett in the first round.

#### **Girls Golf**

Because the season changed from spring to fall due to the results of MHSAA litigation, the girls golf team had only a couple of months off between seasons. They started right were they left off, continuing to improve drastically. They set a school record for team 9-hole score (193) and finished fourth at the regional (two places better than last year), which is the highest regional finish for the team in school history. They also finished fourth at the CHSL Championship, just nine strokes out of first place.

#### **Boys Soccer**

The varsity boys soccer team won their first CHSL championship in 12 years. They also won their seventh CHSL division championship in the short history of the school, and compiled an impressive record of 15-4-2. They fell to eventual state champion Country Day in the district opener 2-1 after holding a 1-0 lead most of the game.

#### **Girls Swimming & Diving**

The girls swimming and diving compiled a record of 9-3 and won championships at the Royal Oak Relays and the Romeo Relays. They were 4-2 in the CHSL and finished third at the CHSL Championship meet which is one spot better than last year. Seven girls qualified for the MHSAA State Finals, including Jackelyn Adams, Liz Barron, Mackenzie Chesley, Kristin Howdyshell, Jaclyn Jones, Alyssa Varsanik and Jaclyn Wilson. The 400 Freestyle Relay of Barron, Jones, Varsanik and Chesley placed 23<sup>rd</sup> at the finals with a time of 3:58.69. Jaclyn Wilson placed 17<sup>th</sup> in the 100 Breaststroke with a time of 1:13.26. Kristin Howdyshell placed seventh in the 200 Individual Medley with a time of 2:16.41 and fourth in the 100 Butterfly with a time of 1:01.24 and earned all state honors in both events. Howdyshell broke the school record in the 100 Butterfly during the season with a time of 1:00.94.

#### **Boys Tennis**

The boys tennis team finished the season with a record of 5-3-2 and captured three tournament championships, winning titles at the Warren Mott Quad, Avondale Tournament and Gabriel Richard Tournament. They were CHSL division champions and qualified for the state finals as a team for the second time in school history by placing second at the regional meet. At the state finals, the #1 doubles team of Alex Horak and Andy Loveless had a first round bye and scored 2 points with a victory in the second round to help the team finish 16<sup>th</sup> overall.

#### Volleyball

The varsity volleyball team enjoyed the most successful season in school history, finishing the season with a record of 54-7-3 and accomplishing many "firsts". They won their first state championship and were the first team to win a state volleyball title in Oakland County history. They only lost one game in seven matches during the entire state tournament. They also won their first CHSL championship and were the first Class B school to do it in over 20 years. They were named one of Oakland County's top 10 greatest prep teams of all time by the Oakland Press. The varsity and JV teams earned CHSL division titles.

#### Equestrian

The club equestrian team placed sixth out of eight teams in their first competition of the season and fifth out of eight teams in their final competition of the season. At the final competition, Samantha VanVlerah won her jumping class and senior captains Rachel Sennett and Liz Bartoli shaved six seconds off of their two man ride time and finished second out of 17 teams in that event.

#### **WINTER**

#### **Boys Basketball**

The boys basketball team had a strong season, finishing with a record of 15-9 overall and 7-1 in their division. They won a division title for the second time in school history and first time in 12 years, and finished as runners-up in the CHSL tournament. They also won the fourth boys basketball district title in school history.

#### **Girls Basketball**

In their first winter season, due to the results of MHSAA litigation, the girls basketball team finished the season with a record of 11-10, wining six more games than in the previous season. They were runners-up in the CHSL tournament and advanced to the second game of the district tournament where they were defeated by Armada 46-43 in a game that went down to the wire.

#### **Competitive Cheer**

The competitive cheer team performed well all season, placing first in their division at the St. Clair and Ladywood invitationals and second at Stoney Creek and the MCCAA Grand Championship at Clarkston. They were runners-up at the CHSL championship and placed third at the regional meet, just one place away from qualifying for the state finals. They finished eight places higher at the regional meet than they did in 2007.

#### Dance/Pom

The dance/pom team brought home the CHSL title for the second straight year. They placed first in the jazz division and first overall.

#### Hockey

The varsity hockey team won their fourth straight CHSL division title and CHSL championship. They hosted the MHSAA regional and put together an exciting playoff run, defeating Marysville 5-1 in the opener and St. Clair 2-1 (in double overtime) in the regional semifinal. They fell to Cranbrook 3-0 in the regional final.

#### Girls Ski

The girls ski team won the CHSL championship, the Pine Knob divisional, and the regional championship. It was their second straight CHSL title and their third straight regional title. They finished third at the MHSAA state finals for the second straight year. Natasha Kosik won the slalom and giant slalom titles at the regional meet and finished second in the giant slalom and fourth in the slalom at the state finals.

#### **Boys Ski**

The boys ski team won their first CHSL championship and placed third at the Pine Knob divisional. At the regional meet, the boys were unable to defend their title from last year but placed second and qualified for the state finals. Kyle Powers took home the slalom title at all three meets and placed second in the giant slalom at the CHSL championship and regional meet. The team finished fourth at the state finals which was their best finish in school history. Powers placed second and John Gulvezan placed 13<sup>th</sup> in the giant slalom, and Gulvezan placed fourth in the slalom.

#### Wrestling

The wrestling team was small in numbers and relatively inexperienced, but the season was full of solid individual performances and tremendous improvement. They were unable to fill all of the weight classes and had to give points to the other team for voids, which made it difficult to win meets. Highlights included Jeff Stelmach and Josh Romeo advancing to the individual regional round of the MHSAA tournament, and Romeo winning the CHSL title in the 125 lb. weight class. Romeo also won the 125 lb. championship at the Flint Beecher Invitational and Scott Koviak placed third in the 160 lb. weight class.

#### **SPRING**

#### Softball

For the first time in school history, the softball team advanced to the state semifinals in Battle Creek. They won their second consecutive regional championship and third in school history. They also won their second consecutive district championship and sixth in school history. They did not repeat as CHSL champions, but they did make national news by breaking Allen Park Cabrini's state-record 80-game win streak during the regular season, shutting them out 2-0 in the first game of a doubleheader at home. The finished the season with an impressive record of 30-12 and senior Molly Coldren was named Miss Softball for position players by the Michigan High School Softball Coaches Association.

#### **Baseball**

The varsity baseball team finished the season with an outstanding record of 20-12. They were 16-2 in their division, falling only once to Bishop Foley and once to Our Lady of the Lakes. They won a CHSL sectional championship for only the second time in school history. Their season ended when they fell to Andover in the pre-district game.

#### **Boys Golf**

The varsity boys golf team won the district title for the first time in school history. They went on to place second at the regional tournament, qualifying for the state finals for the eighth straight year. The placed fourth at the MHSAA state finals, one spot higher than last year, which tied their best finish at the finals in school history. Matt Sheperd tied for medalist at the Oakland County tournament with a score of 72 and was named to the Division 2 All State First Team.

#### **Boys Lacrosse**

The boys lacrosse team had an outstanding season, compiling a record of 19-2 and advancing to the MHSAA regional final where they fell to Cranbrook Kingswood in a heartbreaking 9-8 contest. They won their first ever CHSL division title and the CHSL championship for the first time in seven years and the third time in school history.

#### Girls Lacrosse

The girls lacrosse team won their first ever CHSL division title and amassed a record of 16-3 before falling in the MHSAA regional final to Sacred Heart. The JV team also won the CHSL division title.

#### **Girls Soccer**

The girls soccer team won their district and advanced to the regional final where they fell to Detroit Country Day in a shootout. It was the third district title for the program and the third Elite 8 appearance. The JV girls soccer team won a CHSL sectional championship.

#### **Girls Tennis**

The girls tennis team finished the season with a winning record of 6-4. They finished 4<sup>th</sup> at the CHSL tournament and 5<sup>th</sup> at the MHSAA regional tournament. Lexie Kosik was named All-Catholic and Allison Ho was named the All Oakland County Honorable Mention.

#### **Girls Track and Field**

Three school records were broken this past season, and for the second straight year six girls qualified for the state finals. Junior Liz Barron placed third at the regional meet in the two-mile with a new school record time of 11:37 and qualified for the state finals based on meeting the time standard. She topped her school record time at the Oakland County championship meet with a performance of 11:33.05 which was good enough for seventh place and a medal. Senior Lexi Kosik broke her school record from 2007 with a throw of 98'6"in the discus at the regional meet. She placed second with that throw and qualified for the state finals. The relay team of freshman Gina Apone, sophomore Emily Wade, junior Kelly Kanan and senior Alex Wade placed second in the mile relay at the regional meet which qualified them for the state finals.

#### **Boys Track and Field**

Comprised mostly of freshman and sophomores with only one senior, the boys track team was relatively inexperienced. The distance runners showed a lot of improvement from last season. They shattered the two mile relay school record that had been set exactly one year earlier at the 2007 regional meet. Only sophomore Brad Lorant was a member of both record setting relay teams. Joining him in setting the new record of 8:47.2 this year were Chris Burns, Neil Dwivedi and Mike Deibel. They placed fifth with this time which is two places better than last year. Junior Mike Deibel placed fifth in the mile with a personal best time of 4:41.6, and eventually dropped a few more seconds at the Oakland County championship meet. Sophomore and first time runner Chris Burns placed fifth in the two-mile with a season best time of 10:23.2.
