ATHLETIC PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Boys lacrosse had their best season in school history, advancing to the state finals where they fell to Forest Hills Central 14-8. Their final season record was 19-3.
- Chris Burns won the Division 2 cross country state championship in a time of 15:46 to become the first male individual state champion in school history. He also broke 5 school records in running (5K, 800 Meter Run, 1600 Meter Run, 3200 Meter Run, 3200 Meter Rul, 3200
- Girls ski won a 5th straight regional championship and placed 5th at the state finals.
- Volleyball won their 12th district title and 10th CHSL division title in school history.
- Boys and girls lacrosse both defended their CHSL championship and division titles.
- Softball won their eighth district title in school history.
- Boys basketball won a third straight district title.
- Notre Dame Marist varsity and JV boys basketball won CYO division championships.
- Boys track and field had their most successful season in school history. They placed second in the division with a record of 3-1, broke seven school records, and placed in the top eight in three events at the state finals.
- Notre Dame Marist boys track and field broke school records in seven events. They placed in the top six in six events at the CYO Championship.
- Sara Barron placed second in the state in the 800 Meter Run at the girls track and field state finals with a school record time of 2:15.52.
- Girls tennis won their 5th CHSL championship in school history.
- Boys ski and girls cheer had the highest GPA's in the state for their divisions. Nine NDP teams earned Academic All State honors.
- Competitive cheer broke school records in all three rounds and total score at the regional.
- Girls swimming and diving won the Royal Oak Relays for the third straight year.
